Dr. Kusum Jain, a professor of philosophy (Retd.), teaching since 1975 at University of Rajasthan, Jaipur (India) had been Dean faculty of Arts, Director P.G. School of Humanities, Head of the Department of Philosophy, Director U.G.C. Center of Advanced Studies, and a member of the Governing Council of the Indian Council of Philosophical Research (ICPR), New Delhi. Major areas of her research interest are Indian Philosophy, Socio-Political, Legal, Moral Philosophy and Applied Ethics. Her important publications include subjects such as Human Rights, Alternative Models of Development, Bio-Ethical issues, Roots of Terrorism, Relationship between Economic Structures and Cultural Values, etc., and she has been invited to deliver keynote addresses/lectures in these areas at various international conferences around the globe.
